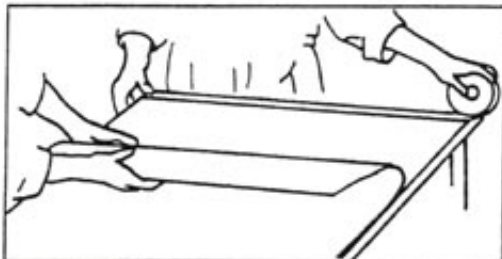
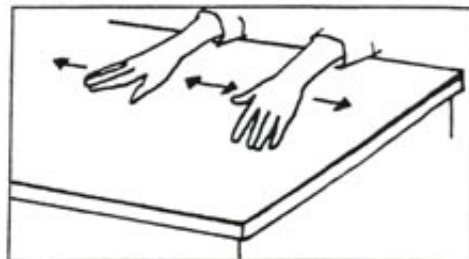


Unroll VYCO the day before you want to cut it to exact sizes.



Position the VYCO exactly as it will fit on the table; then apply tape along the top edge of the tabletop.



After removing protective coating from tape, press VYCO in place and smooth it from the center of the table outward.

#### 1. What to do before cutting VYCO:

VYCO is produced on automatic machinery and shipped in tension-wound rolls. Because the material may have stretched slightly during winding, it is a good idea to unroll it the day before you intend to cut it to size. If unrolled and allowed to lay on a flat surface at room temperature overnight, it will return to its natural flat state.

#### 2. How to cut VYCO:

Use a very sharp knife or razor blade and a straightedge to ensure accuracy.

#### 3. Before attaching VYCO:

Be sure to remove all particles of dirt from the surface of the tabletop and fill in and sand any wide gouges in the surface.

#### 4. How to attach VYCO:

No glue is necessary. You can permanently affix VYCO with a strip of VYCO-Strip (No. 2400-C or No. 2400-B) 1" double-sided adhesive tape. Simply place VYCO in the exact position you want it on the tabletop; then raise the top edge of the VYCO and apply tape only at the extreme top edge of the tabletop.

Peel back the protective coating on the top to expose the other adhesive side and press the VYCO into place. For a more permanent bond, you may wish to place strips of double-sided tape along the other three sides, too. If so, then repeat the procedure exactly as for the top edge, smoothing VYCO out from the center of the tabletop to prevent wrinkling.

**Caution:** Always apply VYCO-STRIP to the table top first, and only around the edges.

#### 5. How to keep VYCO clean:

With a minimum of care, your VYCO board cover will give you a neat, pleasing work surface. Most marks and stains will wash off easily with soap and water or our VYCO Board Cleaner.

#### 6. How to remove VYCO from tabletop:

Since each of VYCO's two sides is equally well-suited for covering your tabletop, you may wish to turn it over to its other side. If you have used VYCO-Strip, remove it from both the VYCO and the tabletop. Then follow the procedure outlined under paragraphs 3 and 4.
